#### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

- All children must be registered by a parent/guardian prior to participating in any Youth Programs.
- For safety purposes, all children 12 years of age and younger are required to wear a wristband indicating their assigned muster station. It is imperative that this wristband be worn at all times. Should the child lose or break their wristband, replacements wristbands are available at our Youth Facilities & Guest Services.
- Carnival's policy is to group children together according to their age. The age is determined according to the child's birth date.
- Parents/Guardians must acknowledge which adults over the age of 18 are authorized to sign in/out children.
- · Parents/Guardians must acknowledge that Carnival uses facial recognition for the safe sign-in/out of the participants.
- · Hours, activities and locations are subject to change; parent/guardian approval for participation in Youth Programs includes activities featuring Carnival partnerships.
- · Guests 17 years of age and under who are not accompanied by an adult in their traveling party, 21 years of age or older, must be clear of all public areas by 1:00 am.
- Parents/Guardians at all times are responsible for their children's behavior and compliance with Carnival's Youth Programs policies and Carnival's shipboard use of facilities. Failure to comply with rules and regulations may result in child's dismissal from Youth Programs.
- Unruly behavior will not be permitted in Youth Programs. Youth Staff reserve the right to remove and exclude from any further participation anyone demonstrating unacceptable or aggressive behavior, including but not limited to biting, fighting, hitting, throwing, kicking, foul language, verbal and physical bullying, threatening harm to self or others, bringing or consuming drugs, alcohol or tobacco.
- · Carnival and the Youth Program Staff are not responsible for loss or damage to any items brought into the facility.
- · Medical care consent is required for participation in Carnival Youth
- The Youth Staff will not administer any medication and/or needles to child participating in a Youth Programs activity, with the exception of epi-pens. In the event your child requires regular medication while attending a Youth Programs activity, a parent/guardian must return to administer that medication. If a child becomes unruly or ill as a result of a parent/guardian not returning to administer medication, the child will not be permitted back into the program. The Youth Staff will not store any medication for any child participating in the Youth Programs with the exception of epipens, self-using inhalers, self-administered diabetic testing equipment, self-administered insulin and glucose tablets, which are permitted in Youth Programs. By parent/guardian providing Youth Staff with any of the medication listed above, parent/guardian accepts full responsibility for any consequence or injury should the child or Youth Staff (if epi-pen) need to administer medication while in Youth Programs. Additionally, parent/guardian accepts full responsibility and assumes the risk of any consequence or injury to the child resulting from the failure to provide the child with any medication and/or testing equipment needed by the child, or if they provide incorrect, insufficient, faulty and/or expired medication or equipment.
