TOP PICK Tour Duration: Approximately 5 Hours

Get off the grid and back to nature in the depths of the Daintree Rainforest. Widely accepted as the oldest tropical rainforest in the world, the oldest part is north of the Daintree River and estimated to be over 150 million years old! Take a ferry ride across the Daintree River for a guided tour with a knowledgeable ranger at the Daintree Discovery Centre and gain amazing insight into this fascinating rainforest. Climb the 23-meter-high Canopy Tower with 5 different viewing platforms. Wander along the Aerial Walkway through mid-level rainforest with stunning views over McLean's Creek. Explore the Interpretive Display Centre, over four hundred meters of elevated boardwalks wind their way through the rainforest. Notes: Please wear comfortable flat-soled shoes, clothing suited to the weather conditions, a hat and jacket, plenty of biodegradable sunscreen and bring bottled water.

MOSSMAN & DAINTREE REGION

Tour Duration: Approximately 6 Hours

10:00 AM

Take a scenic drive through Port Douglas and Mossman on the way to Daintree Village, a historic lumber town. Step back in time as you explore the quiet streets and shops offering locally made souvenirs. Then, kick back and relax on a Daintree River sightseeing cruise. Your guide will point out the wildlife that frequents the riverbanks and share the history of the area. Keep an eye out for crocodiles! Your final stop is Wildlife Habitat, a wildlife park offering an interactive eco-friendly experience. Walkways bring you up close to over 120 species of wildlife. Hand feed kangaroos, wallabies and ducks, pat a koala (or a snake if you dare)! NOTES: Please wear comfortable flat-soled shoes, clothing suited to the weather conditions, a hat and jacket, plenty of biodegradable sunscreen and bring bottled water. Itinerary order may vary. Crocodile and other wildlife sightings cannot be guaranteed.

Sail away to the beautiful Low Isles on the Great Barrier Reef for an unforgettable day of snorkeling and swimming. Your tour begins as you board Wavedancer, a 30-metre luxury catamaran with plenty of undercover seating and deck space for relaxing. Equipped with sunshades and surrounded by 55-acres of coral reef which is easily accessible from the beach, the Low Isle is a fantastic snorkeling location. Take an informative glass bottom boat ride keeping your eye out for brightly colored tropical fish, magnificent giant clams and large sea turtles. Or see the unique marine life living at the water's edge on a walk, guided by a marine biologist. NOTE: Guests with visual or hearing impairments or travelling in a wheelchair must travel with a companion at all times. All guests must be able to climb the steps into/out of the vessel unassisted. Lycra stinger suits are included. Please bring your biodegradable reef friendly sunscreen. Every participant needs to have a ticket. Although infants are free to

participate, they will need a complimentary infant ticket. Minimum age to snorkel is 6years. Kindly visit the Carnival Adventures desk to obtain your complimentary infant ticket.

BARRAMUNDI FARM FISHING

Tour Duration: Approximately 3 Hours 🎊

Cast a line in and test your angling skills against Australia's iconic barramundi. The saltwater barramundi here are renowned for consistent high quality, achieved by being raised in natural, free-range conditions in large earthen ponds of pristine Daintree River saltwater. You might even spot some stunning Albino fish. Tackle and bait are provided, and friendly staff members are on hand to provide pointers if required. You'll have about one hour for fishing (fish must be released back into the pond). Although catching fish is not guaranteed, this is a great place to relax and enjoy the tropical surrounds. NOTES: Please wear comfortable flat-soled shoes, clothing suited to the weather conditions, a hat and jacket, plenty of biodegradable sunscreen and bring bottled water. Kids, first time anglers are welcome on this tour. Observer tickets are available. Guests with visual or hearing impairments must travel with a companion at all times. All guests must be able to board the vehicle unassisted.

After, there's some free time to explore Daintree Village. Next, enjoy lunch in the Whyanbeel Valley surrounded by birds and nature. Finally, visit famous Mossman Gorge, home of the Kuku Yalanji. Discover the rainforest on a gentle boardwalk leading to viewing platforms nestled amongst the trees. See the true beauty of the rainforest as the crystal-clear waters of the Mossman River cascade down the rocks. (river height permitting). A swim in these tranquil waters is the perfect end to a magical day. NOTES: Please wear comfortable flat-soled shoes, clothing suited to the weather conditions, a hat and jacket, plenty of biodegradable reef friendly sunscreen and bring bottled water. RIVER DRIFT SNORKELING

Tour Duration: Approximately 3 Hours

Picture a beautiful, crystal-clear river winding its way through the rainforest with lush vegetation framing both sides of the river. Now picture yourself drift snorkeling along with the current. Sounds like fun, right? Drift snorkeling is a safe and fun way to explore Tropical North Queensland's nature. Accompanied by an experienced instructor, the current will carry you gently down river as you check out the underwater world below. It's a cool and refreshing activity in the hot tropical climate. NOTES: Please wear comfortable flat-soled shoes, clothing suited to the weather conditions, a hat and jacket, plenty of biodegradable sunscreen and bring bottled water. Minimum age is 4years. Tour is dependent on weather and river conditions and may not be available in the wet season (Dec-May). Guests with visual or hearing impairments must travel with a companion at all times. Snorkeling equipment and wetsuits included. Tour is not suitable for limited mobility guests. Guests need to walk on a rainforest trail to enter the river. Ground on the trail may be uneven with some steps and slippery sections underfoot. Sturdy flat soles shoes are recommended.

A visit to the Daintree Rainforest, a cruise on the Daintree River, a walk along a scenic beach and spotting a crocodile or two is a Port Douglas must. Begin with a scenic drive to the Daintree River, enjoy picturesque countryside and spectacular Coral Sea views. At the Daintree, discover the wonder of the dense rainforest canopy from the Mossman Rainforest, it's part of the oldest rainforest in the world and looks like a scene from the Jurassic Period! Search for estuarine crocodiles on a wilderness cruise before taking a walk along one of Cape Tribulation's finest beaches. Friendly, professional guides will share informative commentary along the way. NOTES: Do not wander onto the riverbanks - this is crocodile territory. Guests with visual or hearing impairments must travel with a companion at all times. Minimum age is 4years. This tour is not suitable for guests in wheelchairs, or those with limited mobility. Join a qualified local guide (and local Port Douglas resident of 14 years), for an informative, guided walking tour. You'll learn about the local geography and environment, reef and rainforest ecology, local plants and animals, indigenous culture and pioneering history. Visit the reef and fishing hub, the marina, the historic building precinct and spectacular parklands for some of Queensland's best coastal and mountain views. Stop for a refreshment in route as you uncover the spectacular hidden park, Millionaires Row, the lookout, beautiful Four Mile Beach and much more. NOTE: Please note this is an all-walking tour. Guests should have a moderate level of fitness and be able to walk for the entire tour duration with regular pauses at places of interest. There are some slight hills which guests in wheelchairs may find challenging.
